



















**Map Legend:**

-  Rolling Back Road – typically quiet road over flat to gently rolling terrain. (Mileage.)
-  Rolling Highway – typically carries more traffic with a shoulder over flat to gently rolling terrain.
-  Intermediate Back Road – typically a quiet road with extended climbing – **experienced riders only**.
-  Intermediate Highway – typically carries more traffic with extended climbing and/or no shoulder – **experienced riders only**.
-  Challenging Back Road – typically a quiet, narrow road with steep, extended climbs on poor surface – **expert riders only**. (Predominant uphill direction.)
-  Challenging Highway – carries a lot of traffic typically with no shoulder and/or steep, extended climbs – **expert riders only**.
-  Dirt Road – typically unpaved fire road with steep and/or extended climbing – **experienced mountain bikers only** and not suitable for road bikes. (With gate, typically at the boundary to State or private property.)
-  Hiking Trail/Single Track – **expert mountain bikers only** – not suitable for road bikes. (Check and comply with signs.)
-  Other Back Road – not grade. Road may go beyond that shown on the map.
-  Highway – not graded.
-  Major freeway – no cycling.
-  Railroad

-  Town or city
-  Small town or village
-  Winery
-  Peak (height in feet)
